# ITALIAN CHEESE PULL APART BREAD

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

1 tube of buttermilk biscuits

5 TB of butter, melted

2 tsp of Italian seasoning

1 tsp of garlic seasoning

1 1/2 cup of mozzarella cheese, shredded

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Open the tube of biscuits and separate into biscuits. Cut each biscuit into 6 pieces. Put into large bowl.
- 3. Mix together melted butter, Italian seasoning and garlic seasoning/ Pour over biscuit pieces. Add cheese and mix until coated.
- 4. Pour into baking dish. A bundt pan, 8 inch baking pan, cake pan or 9 inch skillet could be used.
- 5. Bake for 15-18 minutes. Serve immediately.
